Home Access Center provides parents and guardians with helpful information to support and guide their children through the educational process. Parents can access a convenient web portal to view their student's attendance, assignments, discipline records, and more information available anywhere and at any time.

Easy-to-Access Information


- Daily Summary. Includes today's attendance, today's schedule, any discipline incidents that the student was involved in, and any classwork due this week. Parents can easily view teacher comments about student performance or classroom activities and assignments.
- Attendance at a Glance. Monthly and yearly summaries
 of student attendance provide the opportunity to spot
 patterns and trends. On the easy-to-read, color-coded
 calendar, parents can click on any marked days and
 view the reason for lateness or absence.
- View Assignments Anytime, Anywhere. Parents can see assignments, quizzes, and/or tests for their student.

The Calendar tab shows an overview of dates for assignments, events, activities, and more.

Unique Student Data

- Scheduling for Success. Home Access Center shows a student's current class schedule, dropped classes, and teacher's notes.
- Demographics and Verification. Home Access Center enables verification of district records of general student information, emergency contacts, and specific student calendars.
- Discipline Records. By selecting an incident link, a parent can find out more details to see the student's role in the incident, the location of the incident, what happened, and actions that were taken.



The Week View tab shows weekly details pertaining to a student schedule, classes, grades, and unique comments.



Student Performance Monitoring

- Keeps Track of Feedback. Review accessible student interim progress reports, including teacher comments. Parents never have to worry about the status of their student's performance.
- Records in One Place. Parents can view a current report card or review previous marking period records for comparison.

Efficient Communications

- Stay Connected. Parents can view teacher alerts, notes, and comments, helping them to stay connected to their student's performance.
- Email With Ease. Throughout Home Access Center, email links allow parents to click on a teacher's name to communicate. It's that simple.

Requirements To Register On-line

- Internet connected computer with an industry standard current browser.
- Be listed as a Guardian in the student's school records.
- Register with your name the way it is listed in the student's school records.
- Current email address on your contact information in the student's school records.
- Current home address on your contact information in the student's school records.
