The building principal will designate spirit days at his discretion and determine what can be worn on those days.

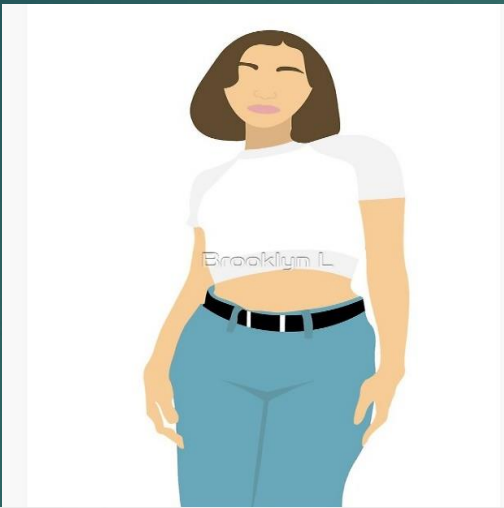
Students who have special needs may apply for a waiver which will be evaluated by a campus administrator.

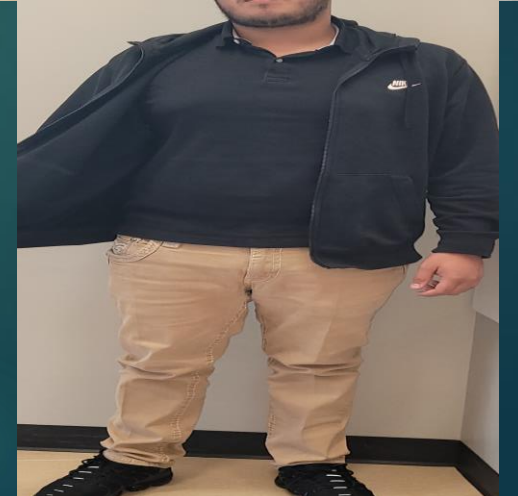
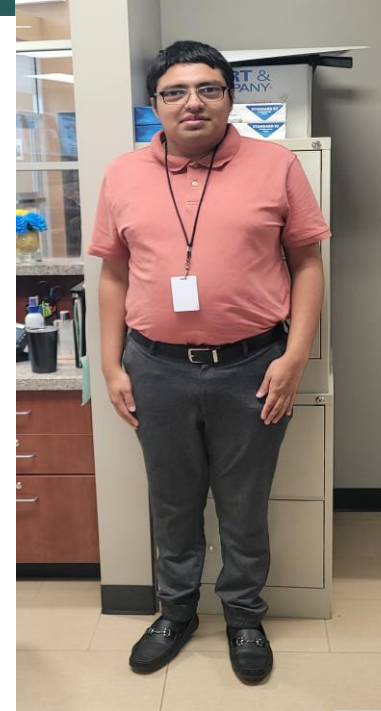
